Participants are expected to cover their own accommodation and travel costs (including transfers to and from the airport).

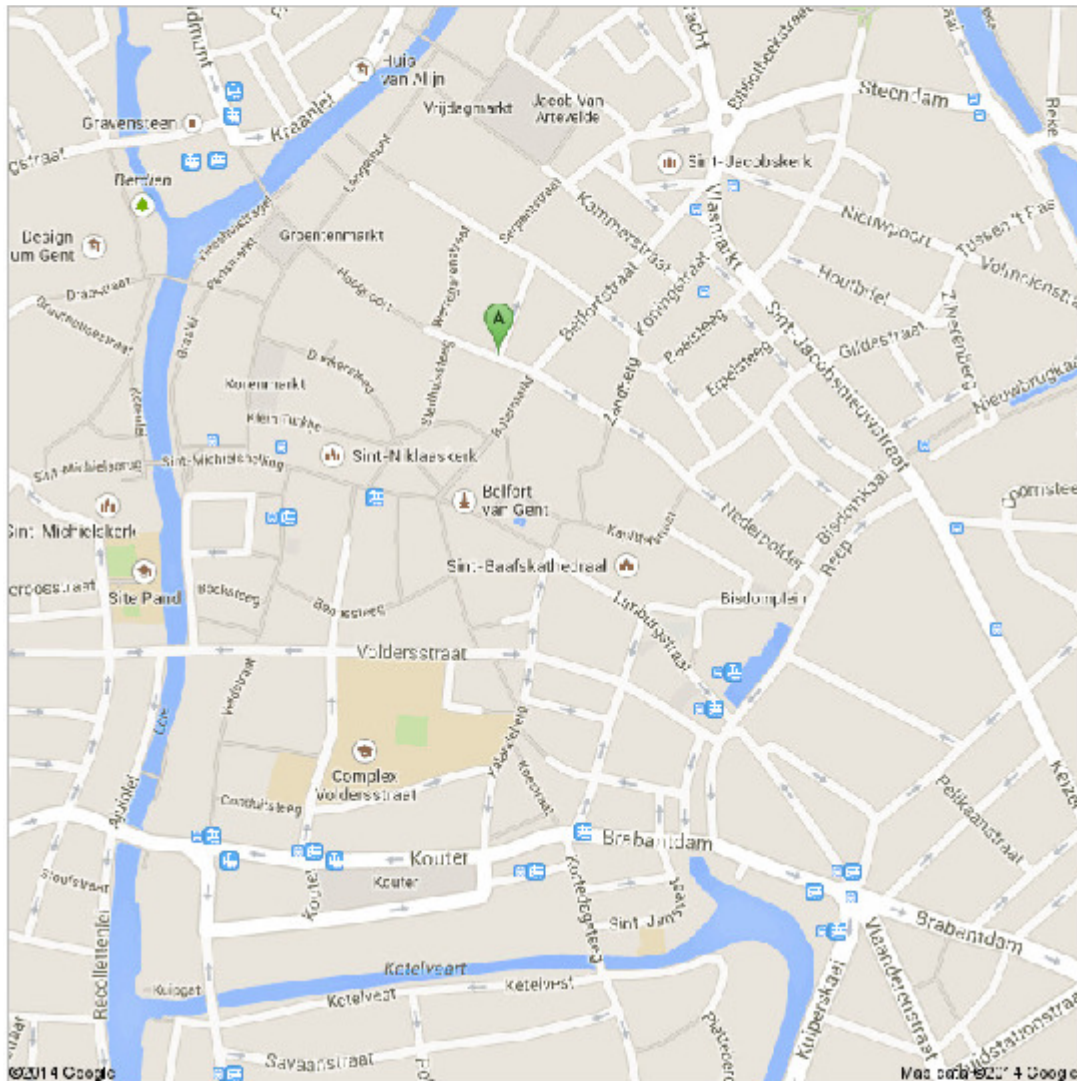
Language

Transport

- ✓ *To Belgium by plane*

We recommend flying to Brussels Airport.

- ✓ *To Belgium by train*

From Paris, London, Amsterdam, ... you can take a train to Brussels-South. From Brussels-South several trains go to Ghent-Sint-Pieters (appr. 40 minutes).

- ✓ *From Brussels Airport or Brussels South train station to Ghent*

From the airport (level -1 / basement) and from Brussels South you can take a direct train to Ghent-Sint-Pieters (appr. 1h)

It's also possible to take a taxi from Brussels Airport or Brussels South train station to the hotel (90 - 105 euro / please check in advance).

- ✓ *From train station Ghent-Sint-Pieters to Hotel NH Gent Belfort / the city centre*

Outside the train station, on your left, you can take tram 1 to the city centre. The closest stop to Hotel NH Gent Belfort is 'Korenmarkt' (appr. 15 min). Please make sure the tram has one of the following destinations: Korenmarkt, Evergem (Brielken) or Wondelgem.

From this stop it's a five minute walk to Hotel NH Gent Belfort.

General information about Flanders

- ✓ *Language*

Dutch is the official language in Flanders.

- ✓ *Local time*

Central European Time (CET) and CEST during summer.

- ✓ *Climate and weather*

Average temperature in March is between 3°C and 9°C. For a weather forecast, please visit the Royal Meteorological Institute of Belgium (RMI): www.meteo.be/en. But taking an umbrella with you would be a nice thing...

- ✓ *Currency*

Euro (€)

✓ *Power supply*

Before travelling to Belgium, please bear in mind that connection to electrical power sockets can be different from the ones in your home country. Please be prepared for 220-230 V, using two-pin plugs.

✓ *Smoke-free policy*

Smoking is banned in hotels, restaurants and public buildings in Belgium. Usually there are specially designated smoking areas situated nearby.
